- Physical Skills Defensive Tactics & Protective Measures

#### **Course Description.**

This 2-day certification course utilizes a combination of lectures, group discussion, and physical training scenarios. As a participant you will:

- Develop a better understanding of moral values and **ethics** as they pertain to your life and profession.
- · Learn to communicate better under stress to de-escalate and resolve conflict.
- Learn how to deal more effectively with cultural differences regardless of whether or not you "know" the culture.
- Enhance your technical and tactical physical protector skills and selfconfidence across the spectrum.

- · Law enforcement, military, and other protector professionals.
- Thought leaders interested in physical-moral leadership, conflict resolution, and ethics.
